Training Day Information

Below is some additional information for the upcoming training day. The information on this page is based on past event practices, and on current public health officer (PHO) recommendations during this COVID-19 outbreak.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions the following protocols are in effect:

- physical distancing, 6 feet or 2 meters is required
- hand sanitizer located at north and south entrances and encouraged
- there will be no concession
- the boarder's alleys will be off limits as will the breezeway along the indoor arena
- entrance to washroom is at the south end of the facility

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

We are doing our best to provide a safe and healthy return to horse activities while making sure we respect our exhibitors and enjoy learning. Here are some answers you may have around the training day.

Where do I tack up my horse?

If you do not have a stall booked please tack up at your trailer. Those with stalls are welcome to tack up in their horse's stall. Please do not tack up in the alleys or the grooming areas used by the boarders

Where do I warm up my horse?

The indoor arena will be open for warm up and cool.

COVID-19 safety plans

Windsum Enterprises Ltd has developed and posted a COVID-19 Safety Plan as required by the PHO and WorkSafeBC that outlines the policies, guidelines, and procedures we have put in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Do I need to read the whole safety plan?

You do not need to read the plan unless you would like to, Windsum has worked hard to make sure that guidelines are being met while hosting this training day.

Where can I wash my hands?

The washroom will be open for handwashing, and there are two hand sanitizer stations located at the north and south ends of the building.

If your hands are physically dirty, handwashing (as recommended by the PHO) is the best method to reduce the spread of COVID-19. There will be plenty of soap and paper towels in the washroom.

How do I need to conduct myself to ensure physical distancing?

Participants will need to keep 6ft (2m) away from each other and staff. We request that you do not touch any equipment that you have not brought yourself.

Do I need to wear a mask at this event?

Masks are not required, however if you feel you are more comfortable or are unable to distance then we recommend you bring your own masks. We unfortunately only have enough masks for our staff.
