COVID-19 safety plan

Windsum Enterprises Ltd has developed and posted a [COVID-19 Safety Plan](#) as required by the PHO and WorkSafeBC that outlines the policies, guidelines, and procedures we have put in place to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Due to COVID-19 there are a few changes we need to make in order to be compliant with the restrictions set out by our Federal, Provincial and Municipal Government.

Please be note that:

1. the washroom will be open for handwashing, and there are two hand sanitizer stations located at the north and south ends of the indoor arena breezeway
2. there will be **NO** post entries on the day of the show
3. **completed entries are due by 5pm on July 29^h (forms, waiver, copy of 2020 HCBC card & full payment)**
4. class adds and scratches will be accepted on the show day
5. weather permitting the show will be held in the outdoor arena and warm up will be in the indoor arena
6. stalls are limited so please book them early
7. we are required to remain under the 50-person event limit. There will be no spectators this enables us to maximize the number of exhibitors we can accept for the show
8. those wishing to volunteer please contact us directly
9. there will be a limit to the number of entries accepted so get your completed entries in early
10. there will be markers set out throughout the facility so that everyone can have their own space keep 6ft (2m) away from each other and staff
11. we request that you do not touch any equipment that you have not brought yourself.
12. if you do not have a stall booked please tack up at your trailer. Those with stalls are welcome to tack up in their horse's stall
13. horses should not be tacked up, ties standing in the stall alleys please keep them in their stall
14. groom stalls and alley's where the boarders have their horses will be blocked off
15. the coffee room is for boarders and staff only (lunch will be in the courtyard weather permitting)
16. lunch will be available for a fee and will be held in the courtyard or breezeway along indoor
17. masks are recommended but not required
