Walk Trot/Jog Youth — For exhibitors that are 19 & under as of January 1st of current year and not yet ready to canter/lope in a show setting

Walk Trot/Jog Non-Pro – For exhibitors that are 19 & over as of January 1st of current year that meets the definition of non-Pro or amateur under AQHA, APHA & NRHA rules and are not yet ready to canter/lope in a show setting

Green Horse (option to canter/lope but not required) – a horse in its first year of showing (no High Point awarded)

Youth 13 & under – youth that are 13 years of age or under as of January 1st of current year

Youth 14 - 18 - Youth that are 14 to 18 years of age as of January 1st of current year

19 & Over/Non-Pro - Anyone 19 & over as of January 1st of current year that meets the definition of non-Pro or amateur under AQHA, APHA & NRHA rules

Open — for everyone, trainers included. (No ribbons, prizes or High Point awarded) walk trot exhibitors can cross enter here to try a canter/trot class and still be eligible for WT/WJ High Point.

High Point for the day will be awarded for the following divisions:

- Walk Trot/Jog Youth (ineligible if cross entry into canter/lope under saddle classes)
- Walk Trot/Jog Non-Pro (ineligible if cross entry into canter/lope under saddle classes)
